

Further Information – Electric Meters

Thank you for looking at our website.

With the huge rise in electricity prices we have had to review how we operate. Unfortunately our favourable rate contract had to be renewed on 1st March.

Rather than hike the pitch price up we decided to lower the pitch price from previous seasons and install electric meters on a pay as you go basis. You only pay for what you use and any unused credit is refunded on departure.

What does this mean and how much will it cost?

When you arrive on site you purchase electric onto a card which operates the meter. Since the start of the season there have been variations on cost per unit, particularly in the colder weather.

However, large units (Motorhomes and Twin Axle Caravans) have spent no more than £3/night.

Others have decided to use all facilities in their units and it has cost more.

Heating and Water Heaters will use the most electric during the cooler months, Fridges, Fans and Air Conditioning units in the summer months.

Average Usage is between £3-£4 per night – Some guests are also using gas which helps to keep the cost down too.

Topping up is easy – All details provided on the leaflet you receive when you check in. As refunds are issued most guests add a little more to remove the issue of running out at an inopportune time!
